Shenzhen and Hong Kong enterprises can sign contracts online

Shenzhen and Hong Kong have implemented an initiative for the mutual recognition of electronic signatures. Enterprises in both cities now can sign electronic contracts through [Shenzhen's unified electronic seal management system](#) (in Chinese only) using the Guangdong-Hong Kong mutually recognised electronic signature certificate and the electronic seal issued by the Shenzhen Administration for Market Regulation. To further support young entrepreneurs from Hong Kong and Macao, the Huangpu District and Development Zone of Guangzhou have launched a series of subsidies and grants. These include subsidies for office rent and living expenses for up to three years for Hong Kong and Macao start-ups and young people who start their businesses in Huangpu.
